

## A Note from the Nurse...

- Please notify the school when your child is absent. Voicemail is available after hours.
- If your child is absent for 3 or more consecutive days you must present a doctor's note clearing your child to return to school and stating what they are being treated for.
- If your child is absent or sent home with a fever of 100 degrees F or greater they must be fever free for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medications before returning to school.
- Please report fever, cough and sore throat with or without vomiting and diarrhea to the school nurse.
- We are closely monitoring the students and staff for flu-like symptoms and are reporting our findings to the Hudson Regional Health Commission and the Hoboken Health Department, with the data ultimately reported to the CDC.
- Please make sure that all of your contact information is up to date. If the school cannot reach a parent, the emergency contact numbers on the Emergency Form will be used.
- As stated in the Parent/ Student Handbook, parents or their designee are expected to pick their sick child up from school within one half hour of notification.
