

Hoboken Catholic Academy
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Sports Program Agreement

Please be aware of the following policies regarding your child's participation in the Sports Program at Hoboken Catholic Academy.

1.) Your child's participation in the sports program is dependent on satisfactory academic performance and compliance with school policies and behavioral expectations. If your child shows unsatisfactory academic effort, or has disciplinary problems he or she will be placed on **sports probation for a 3 week period**. During the probationary period your child may continue to participate in the sports program. If at the end of the probationary period there has been no significant improvement in the area/s of concern he or she will be **suspended from the sports program for a period of 2 weeks**. During the suspension period your child is not permitted to attend practices or participate in the team's games/meets. If at the end of the 2 week suspension period there has been no significant improvement your child will no longer be permitted to participate in the sports program for the 2008-2009 school year.

2.) Your child is part of a team and is expected to fulfill their obligation to the team and the coach. Unexcused absence from a game or practice may make your child ineligible to play in a subsequent game.

3.) Your child is playing for a Hoboken Catholic Academy team and is expected to behave in a manner consistent with the Catholic values of HCA. Respect for themselves, their coaches, their opponents and fans is required. Discourteous and/or overly aggressive behavior will not be tolerated and may result in suspension from the team.

4.) Parent behavior at sports events and parent interaction with the coach should reflect the Christian values of HCA. Your behavior should present a positive model for your child and give others a positive impression of the HCA school community.

5.) Transportation to and from games and team events is the responsibility of the parent. Do not expect the coach to provide transportation for your child.

6.) Parents of those students participating in the HCA Sports Program are expected to volunteer to assist with activities related to the Sports Program, including home games and the Christmas Basketball Tournament. These activities generate proceeds that are used for trophies and special awards for the participants in the Sports Program, therefore parent support is crucial.
