## Tuition Rates for 2012-2013

The following tuition rates for the 2012-2013 school year were approved at a recent meeting of the Board of Pastors. A yearly increase in tuition is necessary in order to meet the increase in expenses.

Tuition Rates for Kindergarten through Grade 8	*Parishioner Rate
One Child	\$4,400.00
Two Children	\$8,200.00
Three Children	\$10,700.00

\*Parishioners from any of the co-sponsoring parishes are given preference for acceptance in the school and will need a **certification letter** from the pastor.

To be considered a "parishioner" a family is expected to be officially registered, worship regularly, and support the parish by using envelopes or Parish Pay for at least six months.

Newly registered families have to worship and contribute for six months before the in-parish tuition rate is granted except for Pre-K grades.

### Non-Refundable Re-Registration Fee for CURRENT STUDENTS:

\$150.00 per child

### Non-Refundable Placement Fee for CURRENT STUDENTS: (to be applied to tuition)

\$150.00 per child

\*The re-registration period ends on January 27, 2012.

The \$200 "New Student Fee" will be charged for re-registration of current students received after January 27<sup>th</sup>.

One Child	\$5,500.00
Two Children	\$10,700.00
Three Children	\$11,600.00

### Pre-Kindergarten Tuition Rate:

\$5,950.00

### Registration Fee for NEW STUDENTS: (non refundable)

\$200.00 per child

### Placement Fee for NEW STUDENTS: (non refundable)

\$500.00 per child (to be applied to tuition)

### Application Fee for NEW STUDENTS (non refundable)

\$20.00 per child

### Tuition vs. Actual Per Pupil Cost

It is important to note that the tuition rates listed above do not reflect the actual amount it costs to educate a child at Hoboken Catholic Academy. **Actual cost per pupil for the 2012-2013 school year is projected to be over \$6,000,** while the highest tuition rate for a student in Kindergarten through Grade 8 is only \$5,500.

Income from tuition and registration covers less than 75% of the school's expenses. We rely on fundraising, donations and other income to cover the gap between tuition income and normal operating expenses. It is expected that each family will make every effort to support the fundraisers that are held throughout the year, or contribute in whatever way they can to reduce the gap between income and expenses.

### Payment of Tuition

Tuition payments are made through Smart Tuition Management. The first payment is due July 10<sup>th</sup>. Failure to make tuition payments on time will result in the suspension of educational services for your child.

The following tuition payment plans are available:

- 1 month: Full tuition paid in one payment – 3% discount if paid by July 2012
- 2 months: Tuition paid in two payments- July & November
- 4 months: Tuition paid in four payments-July, October, January, & March
- 10 months: Tuition paid in ten payments-Monthly July through April
